Cornus sericea	Red Osier dogwood HT 7-10'	Sun Moist/Dry
Sambucus canadensis	Elderberry HT 5-10'	Sun/Part Sun Moist
Viburnum americanum	Highbush cranberry HT 8-12'	Sun/Part Sun Moist/drained
Rosa palustris	Swamp rose HT 7'	Sun/Part Shade/Shade Wet/Moist
